Items that cannot be recycled

Plastic Grocery Bags:

Please seek out the special bins located in grocery or big box stores for plastic bags. Typically they can be found in the entryway to the stores.

Paper take out containers & Pizza Boxes:

Food residue often contaminates other recyclable items in your bin. If the items are cardboard, if must be 100% free of food residue.

Styrofoam Containers:

Although Styrofoam is recyclable, it requires highly specialized equipment and most facilities are not equipped to take this item. Brandon's provider (Advanced Disposal) does not accept styrofoam, please throw in garbage.

Paper Coffee Cups, Milk/Juice Cartons:

Cups & cartons are lined with a plastic coating to prevent leakage and cannot be recycled.

Aerosol Cans:

These are classified as hazardous waste & should be discarded accordingly.

Other miscellaneous items not recyclable:

Light bulbs, ceramics and pottery.
