## ATTENTION SNOWMOBILERS! SNOW CUBS ANNUAL REMINDERS:

- ◆ Per Ordinance: No person shall operate a snowmobile on any sidewalk, pedestrian way or area between the sidewalk and curb line of any street in the Village except to obtain access to an authorized area.
