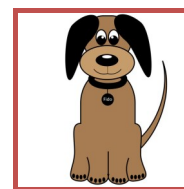

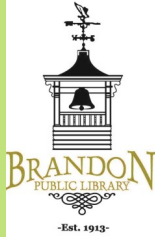

LIBRARY BIRTHDAY AND BRANDON TIMES:

March 27, 1913 the library opened for the first time...or so it's always been said.
