Brandon Ordinances have curfew restrictions:



Juveniles age 14 and under are not allowed on foot, bike or in any type of vehicle on any street, alley, or park during hours of:

- Sun-Thurs: 10 pm-5:30 am
- Fri-Sat: 11 pm-5:30 am

Juveniles age 15-17 are restricted to the following hours:

- Sun-Thurs: 11 pm-5:30 am
- Fri-Sat: 12:00 am-5:30 am,

Note: There are exceptions when handling an errand as directed by parent/guardian, when employment makes it necessary, or returning from a school/church function.
