Reminder regarding limitation of pets per Village ordinance 187-19: No person or family shall own, harbor or keep more than 3 dogs or 3 cats or total of 5 dogs/cats in a residential home.

A litter of pups or kittens may be kept for not more than 10 weeks.

Dogs and cats must be licensed once they are 5 months in age.
