Village Ordinance 404 requires the owner or occupant of any lot or parcel to clear snow and ice from the sidewalk within 24 hours after precipitation ceases. ATTENTION SNOWMOBILERS! SNOW CUBS ANNUAL REMINDERS:

- ◆ Per Ordinance: No person shall operate a snowmobile on any sidewalk, pedestrian way or area between the sidewalk and curb line of any street in the Village except to obtain access to an authorized area.
- ◆ Snowmobiles are able to use the north side of Bowen Street from the railroad tracks east to the Brandon Store and Lockin Street to access the depot park.

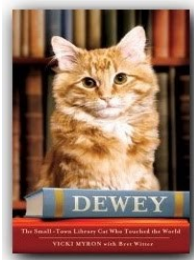
Red Cross Blood Drive held 11/19/19:
