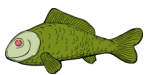

of pond, playground & bathroom
areas, nature trails, bleachers near
ball diamond, within 20 feet of the
Veterans Memorial.

Dogs ARE allowed to swim in
North & West area of pond.
Dogs are allowed on the paved
road & perimeter of park.
