Read a book & complete the questionnaire and you'll be eligible for a drawing of a \$25 gift card! Each grade will have a winner!

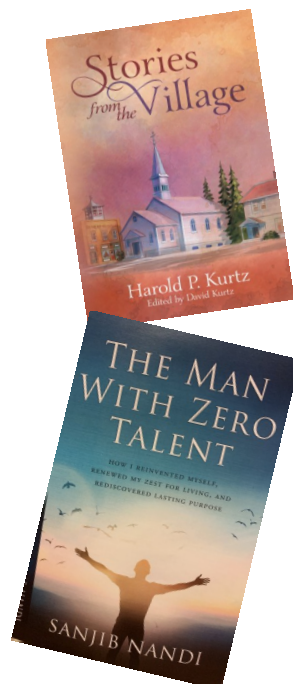
The program is graciously hosted by Pillar & Vine and the Library.
