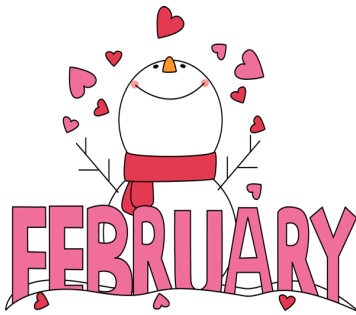

Winter Reminders



- Within 24 hours of sleet & snowfall, it is the duty of the home-owner or occupant to clear the sidewalks. Failure to comply may result in a local ordinance citation.
- It is prohibited to blow snow into the street when clearing a driveway or sidewalk.
- No parking on Village streets from 2 am—6am to allow for the Department of Public works to clear snow.
