

# Dog Restrictions

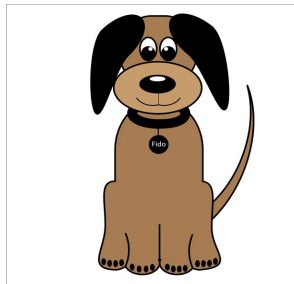
## DEPOT PARK—DOGS NOT ALLOWED.

- ⇒ Only on paved roads & perimeter of park.
- ⇒ They may swim in north and west area of the pond.

## COMMUNITY PARK-DOGS NOT ALLOWED:

- ⇒ On playground, bathroom, ball diamond & bleacher area, swimming area of the pond or within 20 feet of the Veteran's Memorial site.

Good news! We've crossed the \$260,000 half-way mark toward our \$500,000 expansion goal that must be reached before we can begin renovations. We have also received \$60,000 toward our \$200,000 endowment goal. Our main focus is on the expansion, after renovations have begun we will pursue our long-term endowment goal for the future.
