Lion's Fishing **Derby** is back!


- Saturday, June 5

Brandon Ordinances have curfew restrictions:



under are not allowed on foot, bike or in any type of vehicle on any street, alley, or park during hours of:

- Sun.-Thurs.: 10 pm—5:30 am
- Fri. -Sat: 11 pm-5:30 am

Juveniles age 15-17 are restricted to the following hours:

- Sun-Thurs: 11 pm-5:30 am
- Fri.-Sat: 2:00 am-5:30 am.

Note: There are exceptions when performing an errand as directed by parent/guardian, when employment makes it necessary, or when returning from a school/church function.

Lawn Clippings & Weeds:

It's prohibited to blow clippings into the street. Grass & weeds cannot be in excess of 10 inches.
