**Brandon Ordinances have curfew restrictions:**



**Juveniles age 14 and under** are not allowed on foot, bike or in any type of vehicle on any street, alley, or park during hours of:

- Sun.-Thurs.: 10 pm—5:30 am
- Fri. –Sat: 11 pm-5:30 am

**Juveniles age 15-17** are restricted to the following hours:

- Sun-Thurs: 11 pm-5:30 am
- Fri.-Sat: 2:00 am-5:30 am,

Note: There are exceptions when performing an errand as directed by parent/guardian, when employment makes it necessary, or when returning from a school/church function.
