Library Expansion Update

With the generosity of our community and Library supporters, the campaign has reached the point of putting the project out for bids. Our hope is to have the project start this year with a completion date of July 2023. However, with the tight timeline, supply shortages, and high material costs, only one bid was submitted at 30% over our price range. Don't get discouraged, our plan is to put the bid out again in the Fall for a 2023 start date to encourage more offers and hope material pricing comes down, all while volunteers continue seeking campaign funds.
