Brandon Library to Receive Major Federal Grant

If you haven't already heard the news, we'll repeat it:

On December 23, Senator Tammy Baldwin's office announced that the Brandon Public Library will receive a federal grant of \$473,000 to support the expansion of the library. The grant, together with the \$745,000 given and pledged, will make the expansion a reality.

Please Note the word “PLEGGED.” A major portion of the outstanding pledges is a \$125,000 grant from the Otto Bremmer Trust in St. Paul, MN. In order to receive the Otto Bremmer grant, the library must raise \$25,000 in matching funds. The Otto Bremmer grant is a critical component of the total funding. It is essential to assure that construction can begin in 2023. To date, the library has received \$13,700 toward the \$25,000.
