<b>CAUTIONARY STATEMENT TO OWNER OBTAINING BUILDING PERMITS</b> - 101.65 (ir) of the Wisconsin Statutes requires municipalities that enforce the Uniform Dwelling Code to provide and owner who applies for a building permit with a statement advising the owner that: If the owner hires a contractor to perform work under the building permit and the contractor is not bonded or insured as required under ss101.654(2)(a), the following consequences may occur: (a) The owner may be held liable for any bodily injury to or death of others or for any damage to the property of others that arises out of the work performed under the building permit or that is caused by an negligence of the contractor that occurs in connection with the work performed under the building permit. (b) The owner may not be able to collect from the contractor damages for any loss sustained by the owner because of a violation by the contractor of the one and 2 family dwelling code or an ordinance enacted under sub.(1)(a),because of any bodily injury to or death of others or damage to the property of others that arised out of the work performed under the building permit or because of any bodily injury to or death or others or damage to the property of others that is caused by any negligence by the contractor that occurs in connection with the work performed under the building permit.
