LIBRARY EXPANSION UPDATE: PROGRESS AMID CHALLENGES

We want to provide our community with an important update on the public library expansion project. As with many projects of this scale, unexpected challenges can arise — and this has certainly been the case for us.

After receiving State approval for our original plans, we confidently moved forward with construction. However, shortly after work began, a change in the State's appointed building inspector led to new interpretations of building code requirements. In late January, we were informed that our previously approved plans were no longer valid. We were required to make substantial revisions to bring the project into compliance with the updated standards.

These changes have unfortunately resulted in both delays and increased costs. We know how frustrating this has been for many of you — we share that frustration. But we're pleased to share that, as of a few weeks ago, our revised plans received final approval, and construction is once again underway.

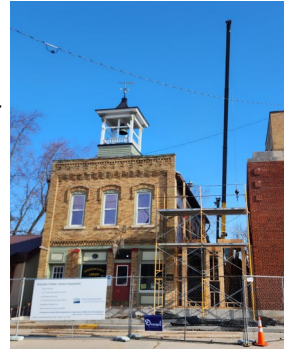
