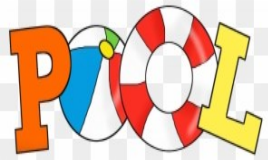

the following hours:

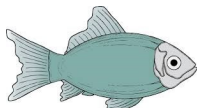
- Sun-Thurs: 11 pm-5:30 am
