Expansion Update:

Things are really taking shape at the library! The walls are painted, the ceiling is nearly finished, and trim work is underway. It's exciting to see it all coming together!

The front door you see now is temporary — the permanent one, designed to match the existing entry, is on backorder but expected soon.

We've run into a shelving challenge. We planned to reuse shelving that's been in storage for nearly a decade, but unfortunately, the manufacturer no longer makes the parts we need — including three full units. We're currently exploring custom fabrication to retrofit what we have, while also pricing out all-new shelving options, including some beautiful all-wood units that would complement the space.

Despite this hiccup, we're still planning a Grand Reopening and Ribbon Cutting on Saturday, October 25, from 12:00–2:00 PM. We'll keep you posted as the project progresses.
